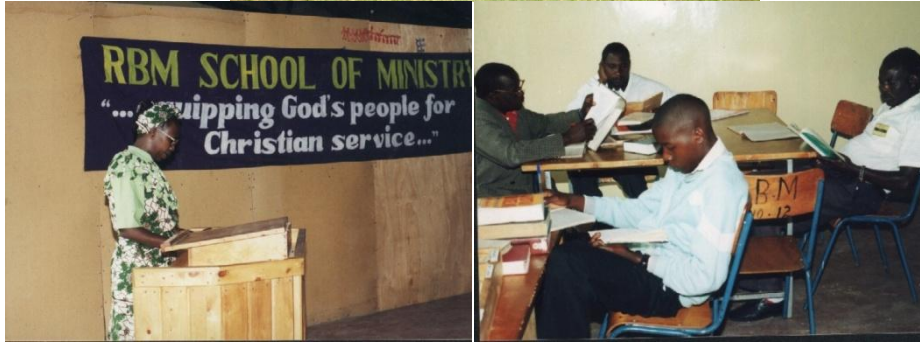
Annual Youth Conference: Youth Aflame

This conference brings many young people for a week long training, fellowship and discipleship. The dates for 2009 conference are December 3rd to 8th 2009. Student ministry is more challenging than any other time. However, we continue to see many students in High Schools, Colleges and Universities responding to the gospel. Our thrust is even more against the fact that more young people are victims of HIV/AIDS.

We seek partnership in:

1. International conference speakers.
2. Cross-cultural exchange programs between the youth
3. Sponsorship for students. Many would like to attend but cannot raise the camp fees. **Full board for five days for each student is \$ 75.00**

RBM Bible College



We conduct the School of Ministry to prepare all God's people for a lifetime of effective missionary work. The training is conducted for two weeks in **April, August and December**. Students come from Uganda, Tanzania, Ethiopia and many parts of Kenya.

We seek partnership in

1. International teachers who are available to come over and teach for those two weeks and do other form of ministries as time will allow
2. Sponsorship (part of full) for pastors or students who come from marginalized areas. **Tuition and accommodation for the two weeks is \$ 160.00**

Clean drinking water: Drilling of a Borehole



We need safe drinking water for the Center. We use Athi River water for bathing. This river comes through Nairobi where it gets highly polluted. As a matter of fact it is the most polluted river in Kenya. Its water is not safe for any human use. For (kitchen) cooking and drinking we buy safe water from town. It is very expensive. The solution to the water problems is to drill a borehole for the center.

We seek partnership in funding this project. Estimated cost of drilling the borehole, buying the pump, wiring, plumbing, tax and others is \$ 27,000.00



Water Tank

We need 5 water tanks to harvest rain water for the center during rainy season. We plan to harvest and store rain water from the roofs of all the buildings at the center. This will guarantee safe and clean drinking water at the center all the time.

A tank costs \$600.00

General Supplies for RBM Center.



We need 15 more bank beds in the dorms to accommodate more students. These beds are fabricated locally and are not expensive. We have extra mattresses which are put on the floor when we more students.

Each bank bed can be made with \$200.00



We need more lecture chairs for classes, at least a reading table and chair in the dorm. Estimated cost for each \$ 70.00

Become a Sender of a Kenyan missionary to Kenyan people. RBM is identifying gifted and trained church-planters and support them to do missionary outreach in Kenya. Estimated cost per person per month **\$ 200**

General support for the ongoing, ever-growing work of Regions Beyond. Our monthly budget is **\$ 4,500**
